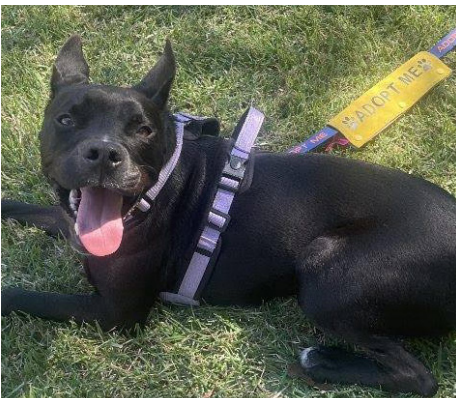

Baldwin County Animal Control and Services is headed in a new direction in 2025. We are hopeful to provide better outcomes for some of the animals that are in our shelter who need to be re-homed. Dozens of cats and dogs are available for adoption which were previously owned by pet owners who cared for them. All the animals that had homes are spayed or neutered.

The community is invited to view and strongly encouraged to adopt one of these lovely animals at a reduced rate. Thanks to an anonymous donor, adopters can take home one of these beautiful animals, which have been in the shelter for over a year, for only \$25. The donor will cover vaccinations as well!

The animal shelter is located at 1395 Orchard Hill Rd. The shelter is open Monday-Friday from 1:00pm to 5:00pm. The shelter will also be open to the public to view these animals on Saturday, February 15, 2025 from 9:00am to 5:00pm. Those animals not adopted by the end of February will be humanely euthanized.

Have Your Important Documents Ready

Bring all tax-related paperwork, including photo ID(s) and Social Security card(s). A trained Extension volunteer will confidentially transmit all necessary documents to UGA's VITA program for IRS-certified preparation and help schedule your final appointment.

Review Your Filing

During your final appointment, you will meet with your IRS-approved tax preparer via video conference and complete your e-filing. Refunds will be deposited via direct deposit.

The Baldwin County Extension Office is offering free tax preparation through the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program (VITA).

Through the VITA program, IRS-certified preparers can prepare your federal and state tax returns, free of charge. VITA is designed to assist qualified taxpayers and to ensure that seniors, limited income families, and others receive every available benefit.

The process consists of two appointments. In the first, you will come by during your appointment time to fill out paperwork, drop off tax documents, and schedule your second appointment. A week later, you will return for your second appointment, in which you will review, sign, and file your return.

If you are not a senior or a low-income family, you most likely can still benefit from this service! There are a few situations for which we cannot prepare taxes, however.

Those situations include:

- If you have income from a rental property
- If you own a farm and have farm income
- If you own a small business with expenses in 2024 that exceed \$35,000, or have a net loss of any amount, inventory, employees, or business use of your home
- If you are married and filing separately without your spouse's birthdate or social security number
- If you are an active military member

VITA can prepare federal and state returns for all 50 states, not just Baldwin County. You must be physically present at both appointments to participate. In the 2025 tax season, VITA has appointments available in Baldwin County at the UGA Extension Baldwin County office.
