Philip Adams Named New Fire Chief of Baldwin County Fire Rescue



Philip "Phil" Adams has been named the new Baldwin County Fire Rescue Fire Chief. He has been with Baldwin County Fire & Rescue for 10 years and has 37 years of fire service experience. Chief Adams was born and raised in Wilkinson County and is a proud graduate of Wilkinson County High School. In 1988, he joined the U.S. Air Force Reserve as a Crew Chief. Following six years of service, Adams was honorably discharged in 1994. During this time, he began his fire service journey as a volunteer fire fighter and was hired full time with the Macon Fire Department in 1990.

Throughout his 25 years of service in Macon, Chief Adams rose up through the ranks to serve as Captain in charge of the training division. He also served on the

Georgia Search and Rescue Task Force. From 1997 to 2003, he worked for Wilkinson County and Heartland EMS as a part-time EMT. In 2015, he was hired full time by Baldwin County Fire Rescue, serving as Deputy Chief of Operations and Training. On February 18, 2025, Adams was appointed Chief of Baldwin County Fire Rescue.

Chief Adams has attained a multitude of certifications and awards. He is a certified Chief Officer, a certified Firefighter and Air Rescue Firefighter, and is a certified instructor in multiple disciplines. He has received firefighter of the year, fire officer of the year, and instructor of the year awards as well.

Chief Adams has two daughters, Sydney, who is a college student at Georgia Military College, and Aubrey, who is in 8th grade at GMC Preps School. Chief Adams has been involved with various community organizations over the years such as MDA, the American Cancer Society, and Georgia Burn Foundation. He enjoys boating, traveling, and attending hockey games with his daughters.


